### HOW TO REGISTER AS A MUSICMATTERS FUNDRAISER

MUSICMATTERS is a Committees-wide Peer-To-Peer fundraising campaign to benefit our Philharmonic Society's Youth Music Education Programs.

Each Committee/Group is a TEAM. Registering as a FUNDRAISER under your TEAM creates a way for you to send emails and texts from your own MUSICMATTERS# page so you and your TEAM receive credit for the donations made by you and your friends.

Musical Reinvestment Incentive: Once a Committee/Group reaches \$500 in MUSICMATTERS donations, they may request 10% of their additional donations as a Musical Reinvestment.


HOT TIP: Once your personal FUNDRAISER page link is entered in your mobile phone's 71777 text thread, it will be easy to access to contact friends to donate.
