## MUSICAL REINVESTMENT

I presented HHPC's Musical Reinvestment big check on June 8 at Harbour View Elementary School during their K-3 Spring Concert! Harbour View used the HHPC reinvestment grant to purchase musical tools: egg shakers, rhythm sticks, and boomwhackers. The egg shakers (they call them shakes eggs used by TK-K). The 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades used rhythm sticks with word syllabication, steady beat and note patterns. Boomwhackers introduced pitch. Eileen Maeda, TK-3 music teacher, is a member of the Huntington Valley West Committee. It was absolutely delightful watching the ever so talented Eileen in action with the students and audience!

From Eileen Maeda, TK-3 Music Teacher: "We start all grade level classes with "Brain Dance" which is a sequence of breath, tactile, core-distal, vestibular movements. I use this opportunity to introduce a wide variety of music genres—especially classical styles. Every class then welcomes each other with different "hello" songs. For the concert, TK-K sang "Hello There", 1st graders sang "Hello My Friends", 2nd graders sang "Hello, How Are You" and 3rd graders sang "Hello to All The Children of the World". These musical tools reinforce musical elements in a fun way! Thanks to y'all!'

Another surprise to cap a fun morning at the school was receiving a generous donation from a parent for music education! There is much to be said for seeing our reinvestment efforts at work and in promoting our mission to the schools!


